



THE STATE OF GEORGIA

EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to and is in possession of approximately 1.636 acres (the "premises") in Meriwether County, Georgia, as described in attached EXHIBIT "A", under the custody and control of the Department of Natural Resources; and

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to and is in possession of two parcels containing approximately 2.779 acres (the "premises") in Meriwether County, Georgia, as described in attached EXHIBIT "B", under the custody and control of the Department of Labor; and

WHEREAS: The Department of Natural Resources and the Department of Labor have determined that custody and control of the above described premises should be exchanged; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Natural Resources at its meeting of April 23, 2003, recommended transfer of the premises; and

WHEREAS: By letter dated July 7, 2003, the Commissioner of the Department of Labor recommended transfer of the premises; and

WHEREAS: The State Properties Commission approved the above-referenced transfers at its July 15, 2003 meeting; and

WHEREAS: I have determined that it is in the best interest of the State of Georgia to transfer custody of said property as described in EXHIBIT "A" from the Department of Natural Resources to the Department of Labor; and

WHEREAS: I have determined that it is in the best interest of the State of Georgia to transfer custody of said property as described in EXHIBIT "B" from the Department of Labor to the Department of Natural Resources; and

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY VIRTUE OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF GEORGIA ANNOTATED, §50-16-61, §50-16-140, AND §50-16-144, IT IS HEREBY


ORDERED: That the custody of the above described property is hereby transferred to the respective agencies.
