EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: Georgia's military facilities are a critical part of our State's economic and civic life; and

WHEREAS: Georgia needs a statewide focal point for efforts to assist Georgia's military facilities; and

WHEREAS: There is a need to stimulate the development of private sector business from defense technology; and

WHEREAS: A Military Affairs Coordinating Committee was created by executive order in 1994 as a part of the Georgia Defense Initiative and whose members were appointed to represent a broad spectrum of regional civilian and military interests from all across Georgia, such executive order and such committee having expired on January 11, 1999;

WHEREAS: The Military Affairs Coordinating Committee was reestablished November 27, 2000, such executive order and such committee having expired on January 13, 2003;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Military Affairs Coordinating Committee shall be reestablished and refocused and shall strengthen our State's enduring relationships with and provide support to our military installations and Georgia-based defense industry; shall support military mission capability by fostering economic development; and shall work to provide a safe, healthy and supportive environment in the local community for military personnel and their families.
