EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: Sandra J. Dean filed complaints pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-10-4 claiming that, in violation of both the Georgia State Constitution Art. III, § 6, ¶6 and O.C.G.A. § 45-10-3, Bradford Brown, Doris Davis, Harold Jennings, and Jonathan Williams have willfully misused, converted, or misappropriated, without authority, public property or public funds entrusted to or associated with the elective office to which these officials have been elected; and,

WHEREAS: Sandra J. Dean filed complaints pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-10-4 claiming that, in violation of both the Georgia State Constitution Art. III, § 6, ¶6 and O.C.G.A. § 45-10-3, Bradford Brown, Doris Davis, Harold Jennings, and Jonathon Williams have violated their oaths of office; and,

WHEREAS: The Superior Court of Glynn County State of Georgia found that the Mayor and Commissioners have made donations of funds of the city of Brunswick in violation the Georgia State Constitution Art. III, § 6, ¶6; and,

WHEREAS: There is sufficient evidence in support of the claim to warrant a hearing for the purpose of receiving evidence relative to the merits of such charges pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-10-4.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY VIRTUE OF MY CAPACITY AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Office of State Administrative Hearings shall conduct a hearing for the purpose of receiving evidence relative to the merits of the allegations pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-10-4 and, if found to be true, recommending whether such violation warrants removal pursuant to such provision.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the Office of State Administrative Hearings shall give the Mayor and Commissioners named herein at least thirty (30) days' notice prior to such hearing.
