EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: In FY 2001, five positions were added to the Environmental Protection Division of the Department of Natural Resources for the purpose of studying air quality issues and structuring air quality improvement options in resolving metro-Atlanta's ozone non-attainment problems. And since that time, the Georgia Regional Transportation Authority has taken the lead role in this responsibility.


NOW THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That, as of August 1, 2003, five (5) positions and \$396,053 in state funds be transferred to the Georgia Regional Transportation Authority from the Department of Natural Resources. The Georgia Regional Transportation Authority is administratively attached to the Department of Community Affairs.
