EXECUTIVE ORDER


BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS: On April 15, the Lagrange Police Department found William Kent Adams in a vehicle shot dead as a result of a single gunshot wound to the chest.
- WHEREAS: A \$1500.00 reward has been posted through LaGrange Police Department and Troop County Crime Stoppers; and the Lagrange Police Department feels that additional assistance would effectively impact the investigation.
- WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that The Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of William Kent Adams.
