## EXECUTIVE ORDER

**BY THE GOVERNOR:**

**WHEREAS:**


The Georgia Professional Standards Commission has the primary responsibility for administering and funding Georgia's Leadership Institute for School Improvement, an initiative that provides development and training for education leaders. The Institute is a partnership between the Georgia Professional Standards Commission, the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, business leaders, the Georgia Partnership for Excellence in Education, Georgia state government and K-12 educational leaders. The Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia has obtained additional private funding for the Institute and has taken the lead role in the administration of the Institute.

NOW THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

**ORDERED:**

That, as of July 1, 2003, responsibility for administering Georgia's Leadership Institute for School Improvement and state funding in the amount of \$931,673 shall be transferred from the Georgia Professional Standards Commission to the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia – Budget Unit A.
