## EXECUTIVE ORDER

### BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On February 5, 2004, At approximately 11:30 am the body of Cornelius Lowe was found dead as a result of multiple gunshot wounds to the head;

WHEREAS: The Eatonton Police Department along with the GBI, launched a joint investigation and robbery appears to have been the motive;


WHEREAS: Evidence has been gathered, but no arrests have been made;

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of a person who has committed the crime of murder or voluntary manslaughter.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$2,000 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of individual(s) responsible for the murder of Cornelius Lowe.
