EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

ORDERED: That in recognition of the importance of faith in times of crisis, a program shall be formed under the Office of Homeland Security to establish a means of communication among all law enforcement chaplains in the event of a major catastrophic incident in our state;

ORDERED: That members of this select group of law enforcement chaplains shall be known as Homeland Security Volunteer Chaplains, and shall consist of members nominated by the Office of Homeland Security and approved by the Governor, to serve at my pleasure;

That the Homeland Security Volunteer Chaplains shall be representative of the different areas of law enforcement, including but not limited to the Georgia State Patrol, Georgia Bureau of Investigation, Georgia Chiefs of Police, and the Georgia Sheriffs Association;

That the Homeland Security Volunteer Chaplains shall serve without compensation;

That the Homeland Security Volunteer Chaplains shall meet at the call of the Senior Homeland Security Chaplain;

That the following individuals are hereby appointed as Homeland Security Volunteer Chaplains:
