WHEREAS: On February 7, 2004, the body of Joshua Bargeron was discovered in Henry County.


WHEREAS There have been no productive leads in the case beyond known associates of the victim.

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the, apprehension and conviction of the individual/s responsible for the murder of Joshua Dustin Bargeron..
