EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On, November 6, 2003, Bryan Cook, a 37 year old male, was found dead in his residence. It was later determined that he died from asphyxiation caused by strangulation.

WHEREAS: The Richmond County Sheriff's Office has conducted an extensive investigation and has exhausted all leads.

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Bryan Cook.
