EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exists at Georgia Southwestern State University, Sumter County, Americus, Georgia buildings known as Jacob Hall and Prance Hall (the "Buildings") located on the campus of Georgia Southwestern State University; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents at its meeting on October 12, 2005, declared by resolution that said Buildings can no longer be advantageously used by Georgia Southwestern State University or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed;

WHEREAS: It is the opinion of Ms. Linda M. Daniels, Vice Chancellor for Facilities of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, that the Buildings can no longer be advantageously used by Georgia Southwestern State University or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the Buildings from Georgia Southwestern State University, Sumter County, Americus, Georgia;

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the appropriate staff of Georgia Southwestern State University, Sumter County, Americus, Georgia, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Buildings and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
