EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to and the Georgia Department of Corrections is the custodian of a residential structure located at 100 Lawrence Road, Hardwick, Georgia; and

WHEREAS: The aforementioned residential structure is seventy years old, has been vacant for ten years, and is in a state of total disrepair rendering the structure uninhabitable and of no use to the Georgia Department of Corrections; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Department of Corrections wishes to raze the residential structure using inmate labor at no cost to the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: By resolution dated June 1, 2006, the Georgia Board of Corrections approved and recommended the complete razing and removal of the residential structure.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA BY VIRTUE OF THE O.C.G.A § 50-16-144, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Georgia Department of Corrections is authorized to take such actions as necessary to effectuate the razing of the above described residential structure in accordance with applicable state laws and regulations.
