EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The Civil War Commission was originally created in 1993 by joint resolution of the Georgia General Assembly in order "to coordinate planning, preservation and promotion of the structures, buildings, sites of battlefields associated with this significant period of our common heritage."; and

WHEREAS: The Civil War Commission was originally assigned to the Department of Natural Resources for administrative purposes; and

WHEREAS: The General Assembly passed Senate Bill 445 during the 2006 Legislative Session, reassigning the Civil War Commission from the Department of Natural Resources to the Department of Economic Development for administrative purposes.

WHEREAS: The Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2007, House Bill 1027, appropriated \$100,000 in state general funds for the Civil War Commission to the Department of Natural Resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That, effective July 1, 2006, the Civil War Commission and \$100,000 in state general funds be transferred to the Department of Economic Development from the Department of Natural Resources.
