EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: East Point City Councilperson, Gregory Fann, was indicted on March 30, 2007, on one count of Theft by Deception by a Government Employee, one count of Theft by Taking by a Government Employee, one count of False Statements, and one count of Obstruction of Law Enforcement Officer; and

WHEREAS: The indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(b), and the certified copy was received on April 3, 2007; and

WHEREAS: The 14-day period following the receipt of the indictment as prescribed by O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(e) has passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Attorney General Thurbert Baker; Councilman Anthony Coleman, City of Marietta; and Councilman Jimmy Burnette, City of Suwanee; are hereby appointed as the review commission to determine whether the indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of the office of City Councilperson by Mr. Fann such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby and to make a written report to me within 14 days with a recommendation as to whether Mr. Fann should be suspended from office as required by O.C.G.A. §45-5-6(e).
