FLAGS ON STATE BUILDINGS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

- WHEREAS:** After receiving a Doctorate in Dental Surgery, Charlie Norwood volunteered for the United States Army and honorably served his country as a Captain in the Dental Corps from 1967-1969; and
- WHEREAS:** Congressman Norwood served the ninth district of Georgia, whose citizens have always been at the center of his heart and the focus of his life of public service; and
- WHEREAS:** Congressman Norwood leaves behind a lasting legacy due to his tireless efforts on behalf of Georgians and Americans everywhere in the areas of health care reform, education, the protection of private property rights, telecommunications and environmental regulation.
