

BOBBY CREMINS APPRECIATION DAY

WHEREAS: Bobby Cremins has demonstrated an unwavering commitment to the Georgia Tech basketball program for 19 seasons and during this time was a positive reflection for Georgia Tech, the City of Atlanta and the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Coach Cremins' record at Tech was 354-237, making him the school's all-time leader in wins, and he was named ACC Coach of the Year three times and National Coach of the Year in 1985 and 1990; and

WHEREAS: During Coach Cremins' tenure at Georgia Tech, the Yellow Jackets played in the post-season on 14 occasions, including nine consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament; the Yellow Jackets won three ACC Tournament titles and two regular season championships during his watch at Tech; and there were six all-Americans, 23 all-ACC selections and eight ACC Rookie of the Year winners; and

WHEREAS: While coaching at Georgia Tech, Coach Cremins represented the Georgia Institute of Technology and the Yellow Jackets as a worthy ambassador, and Georgia Tech is honoring Coach Cremins by naming the playing floor at Alexander Memorial Coliseum "Cremins Court;" now

THEREFORE: I, Sonny Perdue, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim the day of March 8, 2003, as BOBBY CREMINS APPRECIATION DAY in Georgia.
